COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 445, L.D. 1535, Bill,
"AN ACT to Require Adequate Polling Facilities in Municipalities."

Amend the Bill by striking out everything after the
enacting clause and inserting in its place the following:

'21 MRSA §603, sub-§1, 1st sentence, is amended to read:
The municipal officers of each municipality shall provide at
least one voting booth for each 200 voters qualified to vote
at each voting place, except that, at the general election
when a President of the United States is elected, they shall
provide at least one voting booth for each 150 voters qualified
to vote at each voting place.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment would require one booth per 150 voters
only for the presidential election, when more voters turn out.
