COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1306, L.D. 1543,
Bill, "AN ACT Concerning Admission of Certain Children into
the First Grade."

Amend the Bill by striking out all of the last
underlined sentence before the Statement of Fact and
inserting in its place the following:

'Any pupil so admitted to kindergarten shall, upon
satisfactory completion of kindergarten, be admitted to
grade 1, notwithstanding the age requirements of this section.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to clarify that a
pupil must successfully complete the kindergarten.
