AN ACT Concerning Wharf and Piers under the Submerged Lands Law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- 12 MRSA § 514-A, sub-§ 2, ¶ B, sub-¶ (3), as enacted by PL 1975, c. 287, § 1, is amended to read:
 - (3) Occupies a total of not more than 500 4,000 square feet of state-owned land for the exclusive primary purpose of landing or processing shellfish, finfish or other natural products of the sea; or

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to increase the exemption for wharf and pier fishing purposes from 500 to 4,000 feet and to change the word "exclusive" to "primary".
