COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 441, L.D. 1552, Bill,
"AN ACT to Provide for Marine Resources Education by the Department
of Marine Resources and to Establish a Marine Communication Center."

Amend the Bill by striking out all of the title and inserting
in its place the following:

'AN ACT to Provide for Marine Resources Education by the
Department of Marine Resources.'

Further amend the Bill by striking out everything after the
enacting clause and inserting in its place the following:

'Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General
Fund to the Department of Marine Resources the sum of \$55,000
to carry out the purposes of the Revised Statutes, Title 12,
sections 3451 to 3502-A, subsection 2. The breakdown shall
be as follows:

All Other	<u>5,000</u>	<u>10,000</u>
Total	\$20,000	\$35,000'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to reduce the appropriation

by \$5,000 and to reduce the authorized personnel to only 2 positions. These reductions are a result of the removal of the establishment of a marine communication center from the bill. Thus, the appropriation is only to be used for the school education program.
