**AN ACT to Remove the Sales Tax on the Sale of Water for
Residential Uses.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

36 MRSA § 1760, sub-§ 37 is enacted to read:

37. **Water.** Water, when purchased for use in homes, hotels and apartment houses and other buildings designed both for human habitation and sleeping.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill would provide an exemption from sales and use tax for sales of water used for residential purposes.
