STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Concerning the Definition of Spouse Under the State Retirement Law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

5 MRSA § 1001, sub-§ 24, is amended to read:

24. Spouse. "Spouse" shall mean a person of the opposite sex either married to or divorced from the member, in that order, unless the divorced spouse was married to the member for a period of 25 years or more before the divorce, in which case "spouse" shall mean the divorced spouse.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill provides that a divorced spouse who was married to a member of the Maine State Retirement System for 25 or more years does not lose the retirement benefits due her or him just because the member has divorced the spouse.
