AN ACT to Increase the Number of State Liquor Inspectors.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Public Safety, Bureau of Liquor Enforcement, the sum of \$178,101 for the biennium for the purpose of increasing the number of liquor inspectors by 5. The breakdown shall be as follows:
