AN ACT to Increase the Salaries of Kennebec County Officials.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. 30 MRSA § 2, 7th ¶, as last amended by PL 1975, c. 426, § 2, is further amended to read:

Kennebec County: County commissioners, ~~\$3,561~~ \$3,917; chairman, ~~\$3,896~~ \$4,286; clerk of courts, \$8,375; deputy clerk of courts, \$5,857; county treasurer ~~\$5,565~~ \$6,121; sheriff, ~~\$8,974~~ \$10,101; register of deeds, ~~\$8,375~~ \$9,213; judge of probate, ~~\$8,974~~ \$9,871; register of probate ~~\$8,375~~ \$9,213;

Sec. 2. Effective date. Notwithstanding the provisions of Title 30, section 3, this Act shall take effect January 1, 1978.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The intent of this bill is to provide cost-of-living increases for Kennebec County officials.
