HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A", H.P. 1385,
L.D. 1573, Bill, "AN ACT to Control Conversion of Seasonal Dwellings
to Year-round Use in Shoreland Areas."

Amend the Amendment in section 2 in subsection 3 by inserting
after the underlined word "zoning" in the 4th line the following:
'and which is located on the shore of an inland lake that is the
water supply for a municipality'

Statement of Fact

This Amendment limits the applicability of the requirement
for a conversion permit to seasonal homes located on inland lakes
that are municipal water supplies.
