
SENATE AMENDMENT"E"to HOUSE AMENDMENT"B"to H.P. 1385, L.D. 1573,  
Bill, "AN ACT to Control Conversion of Seasonal Dwellings to  
Year-round Use in Shoreland Areas."

Amend the amendment by inserting in section 1 after the 2nd  
sentence the following:

'This subsection shall not be construed to require a permit for any  
dwelling which will not be occupied on a year-round basis or is not  
the principal dwelling place of the occupant.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to exempt the requirement for  
a permit on any building which is not occupied on a year-round basis  
or which is not the principal dwelling place of the occupant.
