AN ACT Repealing Certain Laws Relating to Property.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. 33 MRSA § 652, as last amended by PL 1973, c. 485, is repealed.

Sec. 2. 33 MRSA c. 21 is repealed.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill repeals certain unnecessary laws relating to real property, including a provision providing for damages for any person injured on his land by sheep, swine, horses, asses, mules, goats or neat cattle.
