COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to H.P. 1336, I.D. 1593, Bill,
"AN ACT to Establish the Maine Food and Farmland Study
Commission."

Amend the Bill by striking out all of section 6 and
inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 6. Appropriation. There is appropriated from
the General Fund to the Maine Food and Farmland Study Commission
for fiscal year 1977-78, the sum of \$20,000 to carry out
the purposes of this Act. The breakdown shall be as follows:

1977-78

AGRICULTURE, DEPARTMENT OF

Maine Food and Farmland Study Commission

All Other \$20,000'

from \$30,000 to \$20,000.
