Amend the Bill by striking out all of section 6 and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 6. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Maine Food and Farmland Study Commission for fiscal year 1977-78, the sum of \$20,000 to carry out the purposes of this Act. The breakdown shall be as follows:
