SENATE AMENDMENT " $_{\rm A}$ " to H.P. 1336, L.D. 1593, Bill, "AN ACT to Establish the Maine Food and Farmland Study Commission."

Amend the Bill by striking out all of the last sentence of section 4.

Further amend the Bill by striking out all of section 5 and 6 and inserting in their place the following:

'Sec. 5. Assistance. The commission shall have the authority to request assistance of state agencies, departments, legislative committees or other instrumentalities of the State, which shall be provided to the extent possible within the limits of existing resources.

Sec. 6. Sources of funding. The commission may request and receive funds to carry out the purposes of this Act from any or governmental/private source.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment deletes the appropriation from the bill, — provides that state agencies shall assist the commission in the study to the extent possible within the limits of the existing resources and authorizes the commission to seek and accept funding from governmental and private sources.
