SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1329,  
L.D. 1606, Bill, "AN ACT to Require State Level Assessment of In-  
dustrial Real Property with a Value in Excess of \$1,000,000."

Amend the amendment by inserting after the 3rd paragraph the  
following:

'Further amend the bill by striking out everything after  
section 3 and inserting in its place the following:

Sec. 4. Legislative intent. It is the intent of the Legis-  
lature that the State Tax Assessor be authorized to employ on a  
contractual basis qualified persons who shall be responsible for  
developing assessments of property in connection with this Act.

Sec. 5. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General  
Fund to the Department of Finance and Administration, Bureau of  
Taxation, the sum of \$212,500 for the biennium to be used to carry  
out the purposes of this Act. The breakdown shall be as follows:


The purpose of this amendment is to clearly indicate that the
