COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to H.P. 1339, L.D. 1619, Bill,
"AN ACT to Promote Direct-Marketing of Agricultural
Commodities."

Amend the Bill in section 1 in that part designated "§412"
underlined
by striking out all of the second/sentence and inserting in
its place the following:

'The commissioner shall consult with the farm community, the
faculty of the College of Agriculture of the University of
Maine, and with the various county extension agents in compiling
information under this section.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment directs the commissioner to consult with
the farmer, as well as the researcher, in developing the
report on direct-marketing.
