COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1349, L.D. 1621, Bill, "AN ACT to Clarify the Authority of the Board of Registration in Medicine to Conduct Programs of Medical Education."

Amend the Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in its place the following:

'32 MRSA §3269, sub-§10, as enacted by PL 1975, c. 504, is amended by adding at the end the following new paragraph:

Notwithstanding any other provision of this subsection,  
if the board contracts with the ~~Commissioner~~ ) provide  
of Educational and Cultural Services to/funds  
for the costs of any positions for which the State has  
contracted at the University of Vermont, College of Medicine,  
or the Tufts University, School of Medicine, the terms of  
the contract between the board and the commissioner shall  
be in accordance with the requirements of Title 20, chapter  
304.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to require that any funds provided by the Board of Registration in Medicine for the costs of contract students at the University of Vermont, College of Medicine, or the Tufts University, School of Medicine, should be expended in accordance with the same requirements that govern the state appropriation for these programs.
