'21 MRSA \$104 is enacted to read:

§104. Applications before justices of the peace or notaries public'

Statement of Fact

Committee on Bills in the Second Reader to clear up potential

conflicts between this bill and other legislation. This bill and

the other legislation both enact a new section 103 in Title 21.

This amendment simply renumbers the section of the bill from

section 103 to section 104. It is essential that this amendment

be adopted to prevent conflicts from being enacted in the statutes.
