Amend the amendment by striking out the first 3 lines
after the first paragraph and inserting in their place the
following:

'21 MRSA §104 is enacted to read:


§104. Applications before justices of the peace or

Statement of Fact

This amendment is presented on behalf of the Senate
Committee on Bills in the Second Reader to clear up potential
conflicts between this bill and other legislation. This bill and
the other legislation both enact a new section 103 in Title 21.
This amendment simply rennumbers the section of the bill from
section 103 to section 104. It is essential that this amendment
be adopted to prevent conflicts from being enacted in the statutes.
