COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1346, L.D. 1626,
Bill, "AN ACT to Authorize a Bond Issue in the Amount of
\$300,000 for the Renovation of Leavitt Hall at the Maine
Maritime Academy."

Amend the Bill by striking out all of the title and
inserting in its place the following: 'AN ACT to Authorize
a Bond Issue in the Amount of \$300,000 for use in
Conjunction with Approximately \$600,000 to be Raised by
the Maine Maritime Academy for the Renovation of Leavitt
Hall at the academy.'

Further amend the Bill in section 8 by striking out
all of the question and inserting in its place the
following: ' "Shall 'An Act to authorize a bond issue in
the amount of \$300,000 for use in conjunction with
approximately \$600,000 to be raised by the Maine Maritime
Academy for the renovation of Leavitt Hall at the academy,' as
approved by the first ~~regular~~ ~~session~~ of the 108th Legislature,
be accepted?"'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to provide a better
explanation of funding to the voters by indicating that
\$600,000 will be raised by the academy to be used in
conjunction with funds provided under the bill.
