COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1346, L.D. 1626, Bill, "AN ACT to Authorize a Bond Issue in the Amount of \$300,000 for the Renovation of Leavitt Hall at the Maine Maritime Academy."

Amend the Bill by striking out all of the title and inserting in its place the following: 'AN ACT to Authorize a Bond Issue in the Amount of \$300,000 for use in Conjunction with Approximately \$600,000 to be Raised by the Maine Maritime Academy for the Renovation of Leavitt Hall at the academy.'

Further amend the Bill in section 8 by striking out all of the question and inserting in its place the following: ' "Shall 'An Act to authorize a bond issue in the amount of \$300,000 for use in conjunction with approximately \$600,000 to be raised by the Maine Maritime Academy for the renovation of Leavitt Hall at the academy,' as approved by the first regular ression of the 108th Legislature, be accepted?"'

## Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to provide a better explanation of funding to the voters by indicating that \$600,000 will be raised by the academy to be used in conjunction with funds provided under the bill.
