**AN ACT to Provide for the Issuance of a 30-Day Temporary License Class 2
Motor Vehicles Operator's License to a Holder of a Class 3 License.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

29 MRSA § 531, as last amended by PL 1975, c. 731, §§ 32 and 33, is further amended by adding at the end the following new paragraph:

Any applicant holding a "Class 3" license who has made application for a "Class 2" license and provides the Secretary of State with satisfactory evidence that a "Class 2" license is needed for employment purposes may be issued a temporary "Class 2" license valid for 30 days from the receipt of the application for a regular "Class 2" license.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill provides that a person holding a "Class 3" driver's license who applies for a "Class 2" driver's license because he needs that driver's license to work may be issued a 30-day temporary "Class 2" license. This temporary license will enable the applicant to continue his employment until he is examined for a regular "Class 2" license.
