COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to H.P. 1393, L.D. 1636, Bill,  
"AN ACT to Provide for Legislative Review of Federal Grant  
Applications by State Agencies."

Amend the Bill by striking out all of that part designated  
"§1705." and inserting in its place the following:

'§1705. Legislative review of federal grant applications

The director of a state agency shall submit, at the same  
time that a federal grant application is submitted to the  
Federal Government, a copy of each such application to the  
Chairman of the Legislative Council, the Legislative Finance  
Officer, each member of the Joint Standing Committee on  
Appropriations and Financial Affairs and the Chairman of the  
Joint Standing Committee on Performance Audit.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to change the provisions  
relating to the persons who receive copies of the federal  
grant applications. The amendment specifies that in addition  
to the Legislative Finance Officer, the Chairman of the Legislative  
Council, the members of the Committee on Appropriations  
and Financial Affairs and the Chairman of the Committee on Performance  
Audit must be given a copy by the agency.
