SENATE AMENDMENT "A " to S.P. 466, L.D. 1638, Bill, "AN ACT to Lower the Retail Price of Alcoholic Beverages Throughout the State to Equal the Price at Kittery."

Amend the bill by striking out all of section 3 and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 3. 28 MRSA §451, first paragraph, last sentence, as amended by PL 1975, c. 646, is further amended to read:  
Notwithstanding the other provisions of this section, the commission, with the approval of the Commissioner of Finance and Administration, may reduce the price of liquor in ~~one-store~~ 3 stores, and licensees permitted to purchase liquor at a discount under section 204 may purchase liquor for resale from ~~that-store~~ those stores at the same price they are permitted to purchase liquor for resale from any state store which does not offer a retail discount.

Sec. 3-A. 28 MRSA §451, first paragraph, as last amended by PL 1975, c. 646, is further amended by adding/<sup>at the end</sup>the following new sentences to read:

Retail prices shall be the same in all 3 stores. One of these 3 stores shall be located in each of the following municipalities: Kittery, Bangor and Caribou.
