HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P.
437, L.D. 1648, Bill, "AN ACT Recognizing County Charters and
Establishing County Charter Commissions."

Amend the Amendment in that part designated "§1601."
by inserting at the end the following:

'3. Districts. In those counties that have county
commissioner districts under Title 30, sections 105-A
to 105-U, the county charter shall provide for the election
of the county officers by district. The charter shall establish
the districts for each officer and shall provide for the manner
of election which shall be by the voters of the district
or at-large as required for that county under/sections 105-A
to 105-U.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment requires that any county legislative
body created by charter is to be districted and elected
at-large or by district as presently required by statute.
