AN ACT to Clarify the Term "Population" for the Purposes of Apportioning the Membership of the Board of Directors of School Administrative District #15.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Clarification of the term "population" for purposes of apportioning board of school directors of School Administrative District No. 15. Notwithstanding the provisions of Title 20, section 301, only those patients of Pineland Hospital who are eligible to vote and are registered voters of one of the member towns of School Administrative District No. 15 shall be counted as part of the population of the district for purposes of apportioning the board of school directors.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to provide that only those patients at Pineland Hospital who are eligible to vote and have registered in one of the towns in School Administrative District #15 for purposes of apportioning the board of directors between the member towns.
