HOUSE AMENDMENT" A"to H.P. 1397, L.D. 1658, RESOLUTION,

Proposing an Amendment to the Constitution, to delegate Certain

Emergency Budgetary Powers to a Joint Legislative Committee."

Amend the Resolution by striking out all of the 4th paragraph and inserting in its place the following:

'1. The Legislature may by law delegate to the Joint
Standing Committee on Appropriations and Financial Affairs such
of the following powers as may be conferred upon it by law:'

Further amend the bill by striking out in the 5th paragraph from the end, before the statement of fact, all of paragraph B.

Statement of Fact

This amendment provides that under the Constitutional
Resolution, the Legislature may delegate certain emergency
budgetary powers to the Joint Standing Committee on Appropriations
and Financial Affairs.

The amendment also deletes the definition of "funds" from the Constitutional Resolution.
