HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1418, L.D. 1661, Bill, "AN ACT to Prohibit the Use of Offensive Names for Geographic Features and Other Places Within the State of Maine."

Amend the Bill by striking out all of subsection 1 of that part designated "§1101." of section 1 and inserting in its place the following:

'1. Offensive name. "Offensive name" means a name of a place which includes the designation "nigger" as a separate word or as part of a word.'
