SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1387, L.D. 1676, Bill,
"AN ACT to Provide for Budgeting of State Expenditures of
Federal Funds."

Amend the Bill in section 4 in that part designated
"\$1683." by inserting at the end the following underlined
paragraph:

'To satisfy requirements for preparation and submission
of a federal expenditure budget document for the first year
of any biennium it may be made a part of the state budget
document required pursuant to chapter 149. For the 2nd
year of any biennium, the federal expenditure budget document
shall be prepared and submitted as a separate document, unless
a state budget document is prepared pursuant to chapter 149,
in which case the 2 documents may be combined.'

Further amend the Bill by inserting at the end before
the Statement of Fact the following:

'Sec. 5. Appropriation. There is appropriated to the
Department of Finance and Administration,
/Bureau of the Budget from the General Fund the sum of
\$35,000 for fiscal year 1977-78 and the sum of \$40,000 for
fiscal year 1979-80 to carry out the purposes of this Act.
The breakdown shall be as follows:

Statement of Fact

The purposes of this amendment are to:

1. Permit the federal expenditure budget document to be made a part of the state budget document for the first year of any biennium but to continue to require the federal document to be submitted separately for the 2nd year of the biennium.

2. Add an appropriation to carry out the purposes of the bill.
