SENATE AMENDMENT " C " to H.P. 1387, L.D. 1676, Bill, "AN ACT to Provide for Budgeting of State Expenditures of Federal Funds."

Amend the Bill in section 4 by striking out all of that part designated "§1682." and inserting in its place the following:

'§1682. Budget preparation

Beginning on or before November 1, 1978 and on or before November 1st of each year thereafter, all state agencies receiving or desiring to receive and expend federal funds shall prepare, in the manner prescribed by and on blanks furnished by the State Budget Officer, and submit to the State Budget Officer plans and estimates for federal expenditures with the same content and format as prescribed in section 1684.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment provides for budget preparation beginning November 1, 1978 instead of 1977 as it would not be possible to prepare a 1977 budget unless the bill were passed as an emergency.
