
SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1408,  
L.D. 1678, Bill, "AN ACT Concerning the Farm and Open Space Tax  
Law."

Amend the Amendment in that part designated "§1105." by  
striking out the first paragraph and inserting in its place  
the following:

'The municipal assessor, chief assessor or State Tax Assessor  
for the unorganized territory shall establish the 100% valuation  
per acre for good cropland, good orchard land, good pastureland  
and open space. The 100% valuations per acre shall be based on  
the current use value of farmland used for agricultural purposes  
and open space land used for open space purposes. These valuations  
shall reflect neither the potential for development of farmland  
or open space for purposes other than for agriculture or open  
space nor the value attributable to road or shore frontage.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to correct several  
errors in the bill.
