AN ACT to Clarify the Establishment of the Funding Level for Education.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. 20 MRSA § 3742, 3rd ¶, as enacted by PL 1975, c. 660, § 2, is repealed.

Sec. 2. 20 MRSA § 3748, sub-§ 4, last ¶, as enacted by PL 1975, c. 660, § 2, is repealed.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to repeal the provision of the present law which requires that the Legislature appropriate money annually in an amount sufficient to meet actual education expenditures in the year prior to the year of allocation. The bill also repeals the existing language which establishes for local units a spending ceiling for education.
