HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1451, L.D. 1736, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Charitable Solicitations."

Amend the Amendment by inserting before the first paragraph the following:

'Amend the bill in section 1 by striking out all of that part designated "<u>\$5002</u>." and inserting in its place the following:

§5002. Intent

It is the intent of the Legislature to require the registration and financial reporting of charitable organizations, excluding religious organizations, the registration and bonding of professional fund-raising counsels and commercial co-venturers and the registration of professional solicitors.

Further amend the Bill in section 1 in that part designated "<u>\$5003.</u>" by inserting at the end of subsection 1 the following: 'A religious organization is not a charitable organization for the purposes of this chapter.'

Further amend the Bill in section 1 in that part designated "<u>§5003.</u>" by striking out all of subsection 2 and inserting in its place the following:

'2. Charitable purpose. "Charitable purpose" means any charitable, benevolent, educational, philanthropic, humane, patriotic or ellemosynary purpose.'

Further amend the Amendment by striking out in the first line the word "Amend" and inserting in its place the words 'Further HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1451, L.D. 1736 -2-

Further amend the Amendment by striking out all of the 6th and 7th paragraphs from the end before the statement of fact and inserting in their place the following:

'Further amend the Bill in section 1 in that part designated "<u>\$5006</u>." by striking out all of paragraph B of subsection 1 and by relettering paragraphs C to F to be paragraphs B to E.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment exempts religious organizations from the Charitable Solicitations Act.
