## STATE OF MAINE SENATE 108TH LEGISLATURE FIRST REGULAR SESSION

SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1521, L.D. 1747, Bill,
"AN ACT Concerning the Powers of the Eagle Lake Water and
Sewer District.

Amend the Bill in section 2 by striking out all of that part designated "13-A." and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 13-A. Powers. The district shall be deemed a municipality with a population of 1,000 or more for all purposes of the Revised Statutes, Title 30, chapters 235 and 237, shall conform to all the requirements of these chapters related to sewer districts and shall have all the powers related to sewer districts granted municipalities under those chapters.'

## Statement of Fact

This amendment requires the Eagle Lake Water and Sewer District to conform to all the requirements of Title 30, chapters 235 and 237, which relate to sewer districts and grants the Eagle Lake Water and Sewer District all the powers under those chapters which relate to sewer districts.
