**AN ACT Concerning the Powers of the Eagle Lake Water  
and Sewer District.**

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**Sec. 1.** P&SL 1955, c. 162, § 8, 1st sentence, as last amended by P&SL 1973, c. 70, § 1, is further amended to read:

For accomplishing the purposes of this Act, said district, through its trustees, is authorized to borrow money temporarily, and to issue therefor the interest-bearing negotiable notes of the district, and for the purpose of refunding the indebtedness so created, of paying any necessary expenses and liabilities incurred under the provisions of this Act, including the expenses incurred in the creation of the district, of securing sources of supply, taking water and land, paying damages, laying pipes, constructing, maintaining and operating a water plant and sewerage and drainage system and making extensions, additions and improvements to the same, the said district, through its trustees, may from time to time issue bonds of the district to an amount not exceeding ~~\$1,500,000~~ \$2,500,000.

**Sec. 2.** P&SL 1955, c. 162, § 13-A is enacted to read:

**13-A. Powers.** The district shall be deemed a municipality with a population of 1,000 or more for all purposes of the Revised Statutes, Title 30, chapters 235 and 237, shall conform, as nearly as practicable, all the powers granted municipalities under those chapters.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The intent of this new draft is to increase the authorized debt limit of the Eagle Lake Water and Sewer District to \$2,500,000 in order for the district to construct its sewer treatment plant.
