## STATE OF MAINE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 108TH LEGISLATURE FIRST REGULAR SESSION

HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1523, L.D. 1748, Bill, "AN ACT Amending the Ambulance Service Law."

Amend the bill in section 1 / in the 2nd line (same in L.D.) after the amending clause by inserting "to be used" after the underlined words / the underlined words 'by an air ambulance service'

Further amend the bill in section 3 in the 2nd line (same after the amending clause in L.D.)/by striking out the underlined words "which is or"

Further amend the bill in section 4 by striking out all after the amending clause of the first paragraph/and inserting in its place the following:

'5. Board. "Board" means the advisory board to the

Department of Human Services for licensure of ambulance
services and air ambulance services, ambulance and air ambulance
vehicles and ambulance personnel.'

## Statement of Fact

The purposes of this amendment are to clarify that only aircraft which are part of an air ambulance service are to be considered air ambulances for purposes of licensing and to clarify the definition of air ambulance service to assure that

only organizations which hold themselves out to be providers of air transportation for ill or injured persons will be considered air ambulance services.
