**AN ACT to Provide for the Purchase of Certain Town Histories.**

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**State Library; appropriation.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Educational and Cultural Services the sum of \$2,176 to be used to purchase the following number of copies of certain town histories. The breakdown shall be as follows:
