HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 497, L.D. 1776, Bill, "AN ACT to Revise the Judicial Retirement System."

Amend the Bill in section 1 by inserting after the underlined word "each" in the 10th line (8th line in L.D.) the underlined word 'full'

Further amend the Bill in section 2 by inserting after the underlined word "each" in the 8th line (7th line in L.D.) the underlined word 'full'

Further amend the bill in section 3 by inserting after the underlined word "each" in the 8th line (7th line in L.D.) the underlined word: 'full'

Statement of Fact

This amendment clarifies the language of the bill by indicating that the years served by a justice or judge which are used to adjust his retirement allowance must be full years and thus rules out use of a partial year for retirement allowance adjustment.
