HOUSE AMENDMENT " to H.P. 1571, L.D. 1785, Bill, "AN ACT to Improve Prosecution Services."

Amend the Bill in section 5/subsection 5 by striking out all of the 2nd and 3rd lines from the end (same in L.D.) and inserting intheir place the following:

Prosecutorial District 6 \$40,000

Prosecutorial District 7 \$40,000

Further amend the Bill by striking out all of section 7 and inserting in its place the following:

<u>'Sec. 7. Appropriation.</u> There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of the Attorney General the sum of \$898,000 for the payment of salaries of assistant district attorneys. The breakdown shall be as follows:

<u>1977-78</u> <u>1978-79</u>
