SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1603, L.D. 1806, Bill, "AN ACT to amend the Law Regulating Mass Gatherings."

Amend the Bill in section 2 by striking out the first sentence of subsection 1 of that part designated "§1601." and inserting in its place the following:


'The Legislature finds that mass outdoor gatherings frequently create a hazard to the public health, safety and peace.'

Further amend the Bill in section 5 by adding at the end before the period the following: ', to ensure the public peace, safety and compensation of damage to property, public or private '

Statement of Fact

The main purpose of this amendment is to ensure that those suffering damages as a result of a mass gathering will be properly compensated.
