COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1601, L.D. 1809, Bill, "AN ACT Repealing the York Beach Village Corporation."

Amend the Bill in section 3 in the 7th line (6th line in L.D.) by inserting before the word "roads" the words 'publicly accepted'

Further amend the bill in section 5 by inserting after the 5th sentence the following: 'The fire inspector for fire zones C and D shall continue to be appointed from the membership of the York Beach Fire Department and with the approval of that department.

Further amend the Bill in section 8 in the 2nd line (same in L.D.) by striking out the words "be continued as" and inserting in their place the word 'become'

Further amend the Bill in section 14 in the 4th paragraph by inserting before the punctuation at the end the following: '; provided that the total number of votes cast for and against acceptance of this Act at the meeting equaled or exceeded 20% of the total number of qualified voters within the town'

## Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to clarify some of the provisions of the bill and to require a minimum 20% voter turnout on the referendum.
