HOUSE AMENDMENT "C" to H.P. 1629, L.D. 1832, Bill, "AN ACT to Amend the Laws Relating to Criminal History Record Information."

Amend the Bill by inserting after the enacting clause the following:

'Sec. 1. 16 MRSA §602, sub-§2, ¶B, as enacted by PL 1975, c. 763, §3, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:

B. Original records of entry, such as police blotters, that are maintained by criminal justice agencies and that are compiled and organized chronologically;

Further amend the Bill by renumbering sections 1 to 3 to be sections 2 to 4.

## Statement of Fact

This amendment repeals a reference to "police blotters," which are not defined and replaces it with a more accurate reference to police records of this type.
