HOUSE AMENDMENT "C" to H.P. 1639, L.D. 1838, Bill,  
"AN ACT to Revise the Laws Relating to Barbers and Cosmetologists."

Amend the Bill in section 9 by inserting after the  
3rd paragraph of that part designated "§401." the  
following:

'Booths, attached to or within a barber shop, that are  
operated independently thereof, shall be subject to license  
fees in the same manner as an independent shop.'

Statement of Fact

The amendment inserts a provision about licenses for  
independently operated booths that is in the present law and  
was inadvertently left out of the new enacted law.
