HOUSE AMENDMENT"B" to H.P. 1648, L.D. 1849, Bill, "AN ACT
Pertaining to the Granting of Preference in the Letting of State
Contracts to State of Maine Resident Bidders."

Amend the bill in subsection 10, paragraph A, by striking out all of subparagraph (2) and inserting in its place the following:

- '(2) Who employs 75% more residents in one or more of the following areas as an integral part of the contract:
 - (a) Construction;
 - (b) Printing;
 - (c) Manufacturing;
 - (d) Processed food production; or
 - (e) Service contracts as defined in section 1812.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment better defines what an in-state bidder shall be and creates 5 specific categories most frequently considered for bidding preference.
