HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 1650, L.D. 1851, Bill, "AN ACT  
Relating to Habitual Truants and School Dropouts."

Amend the Bill in section 4 by striking out all of the  
amending clause and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 4. 20 MRSA §3748, sub-§1, ¶B, sub-¶¶ (1), (2) and  
(3) are enacted to read:'

Further amend the Bill in section 4 by inserting before the  
last sentence of subparagraph (2) the following:

'For subsidy purposes, no pupil shall be counted as more than one  
pupil.'

The purpose of this amendment is to clarify counting of  
pupils for subsidy purposes under the educational finance act.
