HOUSE AMENDMENT " \bigwedge " to H.P. 1661, L.D. 1857, Bill, "AN ACT to Prevent the Display of Adult Magazines to Minors."

Amend the Bill by inserting at the beginning of the underlined first line after the enacting clause the/abbreviation and figure 'Sec. 1. Further /amend the Bill by striking out all of paragraph B of subsection 1 of that part designated "§2906." and inserting in its place the following:

'B. No book, magazine or newspaper containing nudity on one or more pages inside the cover of the book, magazine or newspaper and offered for retail sale shall be displayed in a location accessible to minors unless such material is sealed.'

Further amend the Bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

'Sec. 2. 17 MRSA c. 93, as amended by PL 1969, c. 575, §2, is repealed.'

Statement of Fact

The purposes of this amendment are:

- 1. To remove an unnecessary qualification in the bill; and
- To repeal provisions of Maine law which are no longer enforceable because of the decision of the U. S. Supreme Court, Miller v. Calif.
