HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1661, L.D. 1857, Bill, "AN ACT  
to Prevent the Display of Adult Magazines to Minors."

Amend the Bill by inserting at the beginning of the  
underlined  
first line after the enacting clause the/abbreviation and figure 'Sec. 1.  
Further  
/amend the Bill by striking out all of paragraph B of subsection  
1 of that part designated "\$2906." and inserting in its place  
the following:

'B. No book, magazine or newspaper containing nudity on one  
or more pages inside the cover of the book, magazine or  
newspaper and offered for retail sale shall be displayed in  
a location accessible to minors unless such material is  
sealed.'

Further amend the Bill by inserting at the end before  
the statement of fact the following:

'Sec. 2. 17 MRSA c. 93, as amended by PL 1969, c. 575, §2,  
is repealed.'

Statement of Fact

The purposes of this amendment are:

1. To remove an unnecessary qualification in the bill; and
2. To repeal provisions of Maine law which are no longer enforceable because of the decision of the U. S. Supreme Court, Miller v. Calif.
