HOUSE AMENDMENT "D" to H.P. 1661, L.D. 1857, Bill, "AN ACT to Prevent the Display of Adult Magazines to Minors."

Amend the Bill by striking out all of paragraph B of subsection 1 of that part designated "§2906."

Further amend the Bill by striking out all of subsection 2 of that part designated "§2906." and inserting in its place the following:

'2. Nudity defined. For purposes of this section, "nudity" means any visual representation by photographic or other means, showing the human male or female genitals, pubic area or buttocks with less than a full opaque covering, or the showing of the female breasts with less than a full opaque covering on any portion thereof below the top of the nipple, or the depiction of covered male genitals in a discernablyturgid state.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment deletes paragraph B of subsection 1 of section 2906 of Title 17 because the paragraph is unworkable and corrects a technical error in subsection 2 of section 2906 of Title 17.
