HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 533, L.D. 1861, Bill, "AN ACT
Prohibiting the Dissemination of Obscene Matter to Minors."

Amend the bill in section 2 in that part designated "§2911."
in subsection 2 by striking out all of paragraph A and inserting
in its place the following:

'A. This section shall not apply to any noncommercial distribution
or exhibition for purely educational purposes by any library, art
gallery, museum, public school, private school or institution of
learning, nor to any commercial distribution or exhibition by any
art gallery or museum.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to expand the exclusion
under this ~~act~~ to include commercial distribution or exhibition
by any art gallery or museum.
