SENATE AMENDMENT "A " to S.P. 533, L.D. 1861, Bill,  
"AN ACT Prohibiting the Dissemination of Obscene Matter to  
Minors."

Amend the Bill in section 2 in that part designated  
"§2911" in subsection 2 by striking out all of paragraph  
A and inserting in its place the following:

'A. This section shall not apply to any non-commercial distribution  
or exhibition for purely educational purposes by any library,  
museum, public school, private school or institution of learning  
or to  
religious literature.'

Title 17,
